# General Information

## Accommodation

On arrival at Ohakea, all competitors are required to report to the Main Gate where they will be checked in and advised of their accommodation by the Gate Guard. Additional accommodation lists will be posted in the Officers Mess and in the W/O's and SNCOs Mess.

Every effort has been made to accommodate competitors in the barracks appropriate to their status. This is not always possible due to the scarcity of accommodation on base.

- It is essential that personnel use the rooms that have been allocated to them.
- Please leave room keys in doors and fold the linen on your departure – failure to comply may incur charges.
- All rooms to be vacated NLT 1000h on Friday 04 November 2022.

## Security

**All serving players are to be in possession of NZDF identification. Ex-serving players will receive 'Un-Escorted' Visitors access.**

**The visitor pass must be carried at all times whilst on Base and shown to security staff when entering through the main gate, so take it with you when you leave to go to the golf course.**

**Personnel are to stay within the confines of the accommodation/mess area when on base. There should be no need for anyone to be on the operational side of base (denoted by red line on road).**

Dress code for the week is 'relaxed' and competitors are reminded that a collar and tie or female equivalent is the minimum requirement at the presentation ceremony and buffet meal on Thursday.

## Course Facilities

### PRACTICE AREA

The alternative 9th green has now been designated as a chipping/putting green. **No** long shots please. A practice area is allocated from beside the 8th Blue tee towards and down the 8th fairway. Please refrain from taking practice shots from the fairways.

### PRACTICE ON ANY OTHER PART OF THE COURSE PRIOR TO THE STROKE ROUND IS NOT PERMITTED.

During Matchplay rounds avoid playing on other areas of the course, have consideration to those who are playing early matches and do not leave practice balls through the green.

## Carts

Golf carts may only be used by players in possession of a certificate issued by an appropriate medical authority. Other members playing in the same 'four' are not to utilize the cart, as an unfair advantage may result (i.e. Fatigue and/or fitness).

## Practice Round

The Rangitikei Course will be available for the official practice round for all competitors is on Sunday 30 October 2022. You will need to book ahead for a time slot as Sundays can be very busy.

**Could each group please carry a sand bucket and replace all divots.**

## Photographs

There will be a group photograph on No 10 Tee between 0800 - 0810h on Tuesday 01 November 22 - all players are encouraged to attend.

## Conditions of Play

Every competitor in the Tournament must be a current financial member of the RNZAF Golfing Society and have an official World Handicap System handicap index.

In all competitions, Men and Women will compete off the club tees (Men will use White tees and Women will use Yellow tees).

### 36 Hole Qualifying Gross Score Adjustment

Women playing in the 36 hole qualifying round of stroke play competition at Rangitikei will have 1 strokes subtracted from their total 36 hole gross score.

### 36 Hole Qualifying Handicaps

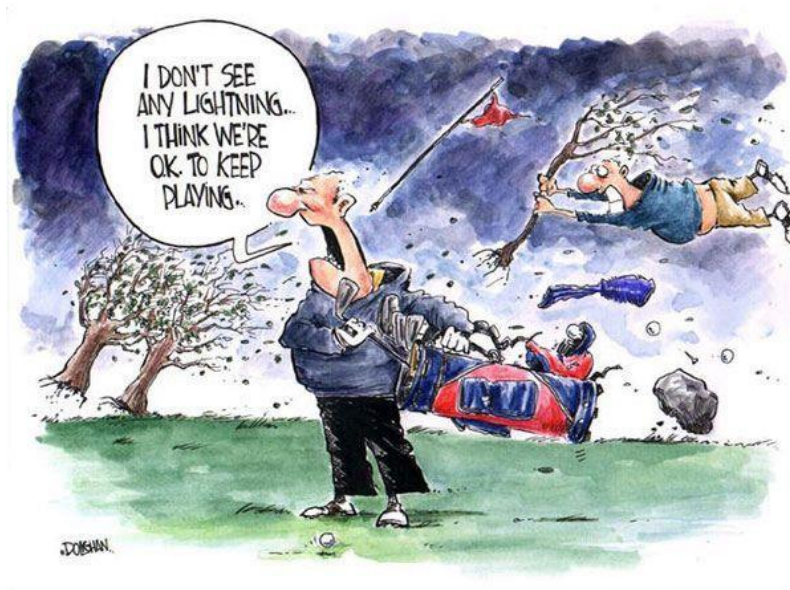
WHS handicap indexes will be frozen for the qualifying rounds (i.e. as of 30 October). From Tuesday morning, handicap matches will be played using current WHS handicap index.

### Suspension of Play

Should the weather deteriorate to where the safety of players is questioned an air horn will sound. On this sound please complete the hole you are playing. Do not tee off if you are on a tee. Return to the club house.

Two blasts in quick succession means an immediate suspension of play; mark your ball where it is and take shelter at the club house.

Play will only commence when the immediate danger has past, again a blast on the horn will signal the recommencement play.



# General Rules and Etiquette

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf, NZGA Rules, and Local Rules of the host club and competition rules as laid down in the Conditions of Competition.

In order to maintain the good reputation the RNZAF has, members are respectfully reminded that rakes are provided at each bunker for the convenience and benefit of all players. Please use the rakes and remove evidence of your visit.

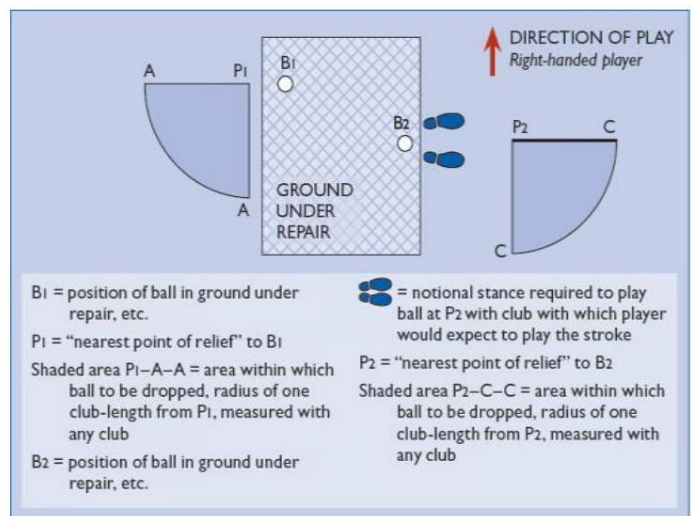
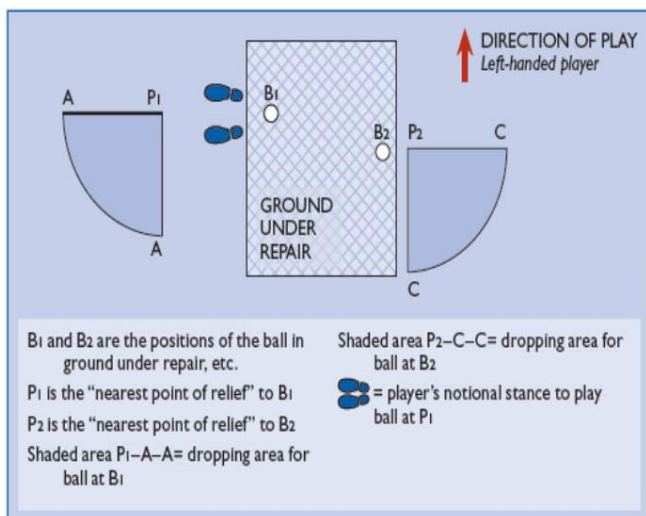
## Preferred Lie

As the course is recovering from extensive tree removal this year the 2022 tournament committee has decided to apply a 15cm ( 6 inch) mark, lift, clean and place 'through the green' rule.

## Local Rules

Check the Local Rule Board for any additional course rules.

- Embedded ball through the green in rough, clean and drop as near as possible to the spot where it lay no nearer the hole. (Rule 16.3)
- Relief (Rule 14.3) from burrowing animal scrapings through the green.
- Relief (Rule 14.3) from exposed tree roots in general area (Rule 16.1b).
- GUR defined by blue pegs – free drop nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.

## Nearest the Centre

Contested on the 4<sup>th</sup> hole and is closest to center of the mown fairway. This is divided into Men's and Women's divisions; **please ensure you have the correct card before writing your name on it.**

## Nearest the Pin

Contested on all par 3's for all players (Ball must be on the putting surface).

## Nearest the Pin in 2 (Men's)

Contested on the 18th hole (ball must be on the putting surface to count). These are divided into handicap divisions (0-14 & 15+); **please ensure you have the correct card before writing your name on it.**

## Nearest the Pin in 2 (Women's)

Contested on the 11th hole (ball must be on the putting surface to count). This open to all ladies; **please ensure you have the correct card before writing your name on it.**

2nd Round of 36 Hole Qualifying – 18 holes (Bogey hagggle)

## Individual Trophies

**SOCIETY PLAQUE** - Lowest gross score over 36 holes. (In the event of a tie, the winner is to be decided by sudden death playoff commencing at hole No 1).

**BOB WESTON CUP** - Runner-Up lowest gross score over 36 holes.

**SOCIETY SALVER** - Lowest Net score (0 - 18 handicap) over 36 holes.

**WHENUAPAI TROPHY** - Lowest Net score (19 - 36+ handicap) over 36 holes.

**PARTISAN PLATE** - Lowest Net score over the first 18 holes by a member of the Society who is an ex member of the RNZAF. (18 Hole Division players qualify on their stroke round played on Monday).

**WINGS CUP** - Lowest Net score over the first 18 holes by a member of the Society who are aircrew, or have served in an aircrew branch. (18 Hole Division players qualify on their stroke round played on Monday).

**WRNZAF CUP** - Lowest Net score by a Serving or Ex Service Woman from the first round, during the stroke rounds. (18 Hole Division Ladies qualify on their stroke round played on Monday).

**GLEDHILL CUP** - Lowest Net score over 36 hole qualifying by a female member of the Society.

**JOE BAKER TROPHY** - Lowest Net score over 36 holes by a left handed member of the Society from the first round, during the stroke rounds.

## Teams Trophies

**SEABROOK TROPHY** – Team lowest aggregate Net score over 36 holes.

Team of six players from each Base - Auckland, Ohakea, Wellington, Woodbourne and Remote (Remote being those Society members who have joined directly through the Society Secretary) may be entered to compete for the Seabrook Trophy.

Teams are to be selected by their respective Area Captains and are to be handed to the Tournament Management Committee no later than 0750hrs on Monday 02 November.



**ANDY LEE TROPHY** - The Andy Lee Trophy (lowest aggregate score) will be competed for by 8 man teams representing the Current Serving Society Members (Civilian and Uniformed) and Retired Society Members. **Note: Seabrook team member's scores are ineligible to compete for this trophy.**

## Ambrose – 2 Player Teams

**Thursday Afternoon** – Those players who do wish to play more golf, can pair up with another pair and play a round of Ambrose off available tees – check with the starters.

**Rules** – Not too many really, go out and have fun.

1. Team of two.
2. Combined course handicap, divided by 4. Round up.
3. Players must use 9 tee shots each
4. Score card must be signed by other team in the group
5. Final score = Net. (Team gross - team handicap).

## 36 Hole Match Play

**Note:** Due to the change in tournament format to divisions of 8, the divisions will fill up from division 7 meaning that division 1 will have any byes.

### RNZAF GOLFING SOCIETY CHAMPIONSHIP (Div. 1)

The first 16 (15 for 2022) RNZAF Golfing Society members, in gross score order, will qualify to play for the RNZAF Golfing Society Championship. In cases of a tie for a position, the position will be decided by lot. Play for the RNZAF Golfing Society Championship is to be decided by knockout by match play 'off the stick'; - Championship Plate Flight and Plate Flight events are to be knockout by match play on handicap.

Further divisions of 8 will play for the Championship, Championship Plate, Flight and Plate Flight for the following trophies are to be match play on handicap:

**Society Championship (Mincer) (Div. 2)**  
**Ellis Trophy (Rangitikei Handicap) (Div. 4)**  
**Wigram Trophy (Div. 6)**

**Tyro Cup (Div. 3)**  
**Kangaroo Cup (Div. 5)**  
**PSIS Trophy (Div. 7)**

Score cards must be completed and handed to the Tournament Management Committee within 15 minutes of the completion of each round.

All competitors are to advise any discrepancies with handicap indexing with the Tournament Management Committee PRIOR to the commencement of the Tournament.

Play commences at 0800hrs on Wednesday 02 November, for the 36 hole players. All players are to report to the Starter not less than 10 minutes before their designated starting time.

Halved matches. For matches that are halved after 18 holes, a 'sudden death' playoff shall commence from the 19th hole, being that hole from which the match started, until one side or the other wins a hole, strokes being given and received as in the stipulated round.

### **Wednesday 02 November**

Morning:

- First round of matches for Championship – all Divisions.

Afternoon:

- Second round of matches for Championship – all Divisions.

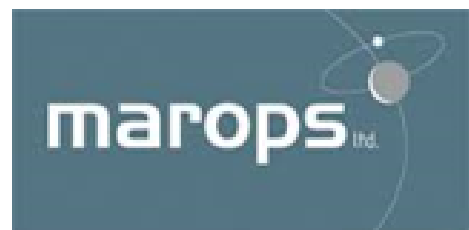
